## 5. Summary of nominee's achievements, contributions, leadership (national & International) and /or impact to the field. [2 pages]

This should be a description of the nominee's major scientific contributions in relation to the objectives of the Award, the significance of these contributions, an explanation as to why the nominee is especially qualified to receive the Award, and a description of the nominee's contribution where the nominee has been part of a research team or teams. Highlight the leadership roles of the nominee in the field of biochemistry and/or molecular biology and the impact to the field. An example of leadership could include heading a national institute or in the case of nominees who are from industry, how the candidate may have initiated or led programmes that had significant impact to the field. Impact can include publications that were highly cited and key for the development of new technologies.

### 6. Representative list of the nominee's peer reviewed publications (single spaced)

This list should not include abstracts.

The 10 best representative publications with a brief annotation for each paper (not exceeding 70 words) to describe its significance. Numbers of citations, the impact factor of the journal, and the ranking of that journal within its field based on impact factor (specify field if not Biochemistry and Molecular Biology), must be given for these 10 publications.
